




Highlights


- Europe: continent of migration & social welfare
 - 10% of world's people, 25% of world's countries, 35% of international migrants, 50% of social welfare spending
- Net migration: 500,000 to 700,000 a year, versus 1 million+ a year in US. Half to Germany & UK
- EU leaders: Europe needs migrants, but EU should select migrants, not migrants select Europe
 - Dublin: asylum seekers should apply in the first EU country they reach, and this decision is binding on all EU member states
 - Schengen: once inside Schengen, no border checks on foreigners or nationals
 - Blue Card & foreign students: make it easier for foreign professionals to enter with families, graduates to stay

Migration crisis 1992: 438,000 to Germany from Balkans Dublin & national reforms: require visas & carrier sanctions, safe third countries, peace in Balkans





EU migration 2012: Non-EU arrivals (green) 1.4 million or 4,000 a day, asylum applicants (orange) 1,000 a day, irregular (blue) 200 a day



Europe needs immigrants: but EU member states want to select migrants they need, not migrants selecting Europe





3,700 Blue cards issued in 2012; 70% by Germany; 15,300 in 2013, 93% by Germany to foreigners already in Germany

Arab spring began in 2011: Yemen, Libya, Syria, Tunisia, Egypt
Displacement and civil war in Libya, Yemen, and Syria



Africans cross Mediterranean















Crossing the Mediterranean

Smugglers working mostly in Libya have made the sea's central region the main migrant transit route to Europe.





Syria had 22 million people in 2010. Over 4 million were registered refugees outside Syria in summer 2015 Where to spend money? UNHCR: \$7 billion in 2015 for 13 million refugees Germany: \$7 billion for 800,000

Merkel: August 25, 2015. Dublin regs for Syrians are suspended (Germany will not return Syrians to Austria)

Migrants buy life jackets & boats to get to Greek islands. Everything is for sale. France's honorary consul in Bodrum resigned after she sold rubber boats to migrants








From Greek islands to Piraeus by ferry





Over 12,200 migrants arrived in Munich, Sat Sept 12, 2015

Volunteers providing food to asylum seekers: Vienna




