## THE PRESIDENT'S ACTION IS...

26% GOOD FOR THE COUNTRY



## IN TERMS OF POLICY:

49% HARMFUL TO CHANCES FOR LEGISLATIVE REFORM.

46% REASONABLE IN TERMS OF ACTUAL POLICY.

46% GOING TO REDUCE UNCERTAINTY FOR EXISTING ILLEGAL IMMIGRANT WORKERS.

46% INCREASING INCENTIVES FOR FUTURE ILLEGAL MIGRATION.

38% LIKELY TO INCREASE THE U.S. LABOR FORCE PARTICIPATION RATE (A CEA ASSUMPTION).

13% NOT AS IMPORTANT AS EXPECTED.




## IN TERMS OF LAW:

46% A DANGEROUS PRECEDENT.

44% DIFFICULT TO REVERSE BY FUTURE PRESIDENTS.

33% unconstitutional.

26% EQUIVALENT IN SCOPE TO EXECUTIVE ACTIONS BY PREVIOUS U.S. PRESIDENTS.
